

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to increase certain appropriations in the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Request Act pursuant to the District of Columbia Appropriations Act, 2015.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Fiscal Year 2015 Revised Budget Request Congressional Review Emergency Adjustment Resolution of 2014”.

Sec. 2. (a) On December 17, 2014, the Council passed Act 20-545, the Fiscal Year 2015 Revised Budget Request Emergency Adjustment Act of 2014. The act was signed by the Mayor on December 23, 2014. Act 20-545 will expire on March 24, 2014.

(b) On January 6, 2015, the Council passed Act 20-627, the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Request Temporary Adjustment Act of 2015, a temporary version of Act 20-545. The Mayor signed that temporary legislation on February 5, 2015, and it is currently undergoing congressional review. It is unclear when the review period will end and, thus, when Act 20-627 will become law.

(c) Acts 20-545 and 20-627 provide important funding necessary for the development of a soccer stadium (as authorized by Act 20-556, the District of Columbia Soccer Stadium

1 Development Act of 2014) as well as carryover budget authority for the District of Columbia  
2 Auditor.

3 (d) The congressional review period for Act 20-627 will create a funding and authority gap  
4 upon the expiration of Act 20-545. This gap must be avoided for the proper implementation of Act  
5 20-556 and the balancing of the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget and Financial Plan.

6 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
7 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Fiscal  
8 Year 2015 Revised Budget Request Congressional Review Emergency Adjustment Act of 2015  
9 be adopted after a single reading.

10 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
