No. 67-1

Amendment of District of Columbia Regulation, Alcoholic Beverage Control, to prohibit the solicitation by entertainers or employees in class C or D establishments of any drink.

BE IT ENACTED by the District of Columbia Council that:

Section 1, Title 2 of the District of Columbia Regulations, Alcoholic Beverage Control, is hereby amended by adding the following new section:

Section 2.155. Solicitation of Drinks.

"No retail licensee, class C or D, shall require, permit, suffer, encourage, or induce any entertainer or employee to solicit in the licensed premises for herself or himself or for any person other than the patron and guests of the patron, the purchase by the patron of any drink, whether alcoholic or non-alcoholic, or money with which to purchase the same; nor shall any retail licensee, class C or D, pay a commission or any other compensation to any person frequenting his establishment or to his agent or manager to solicit for herself, himself, or for others, the purchase by the patron of any drink, whether alcoholic or non-alcoholic."

The next item of business related to the proposed resolution approving the modifications of boundaries and the modifications of urban renewal plan for Northwest Urban Renewal Area No. 1. Mr. Turner moved the adoption of the said resolution. After discussion, Mr. Turner moved that the matter be deferred for one week. The motion carried by an 8 to 1 vote, Chairman Hechinger voting in the negative.

The next item of business related to a requested amendment in the supplemental budget request for 1968. The Chairman called upon the Acting Secretary to read a letter received from the Commissioner of the District of Columbia requesting that the item in the supplemental budget approved by the Council at its November 16, 1967, meeting be amended by adding \$12,800. The item as approved was in the amount of \$15,300. The requested adjustment would increase the total request from \$5,209,600 to \$5, 222,400. Upon motion by Mr. Anderson the requested amendment was unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 10:55 a.m. by unanimous consent.

Amendment of Housing Regulations to require a lavatory, water closet and bathing facility for the exclusive use of the occupants of such dwelling unit.


BE IT ENACTED by the District of Columbia Council that:

Section 1. Section 2403.21 of the Housing Regulations of the District of Columbia is amended to read as follows:

"2403.21. On and after January 1, 1968, each dwelling unit shall contain a lavatory, water closet and bathing facility for the exclusive use of the occupants of such dwelling unit: Provided, That roomers renting space within a dwelling unit shall be permitted to share the use of the water closet, lavatory and bathing facility to the extent authorized by Section 2403.22."

Section 2. Effective Date. This amendment shall become effective twenty days after the date of its passage.

Amendment to Housing Regulations of the District of Columbia to prohibit the use of any structure as a tenement unit or tenement house.


BE IT ENACTED by the District of Columbia Council that:

Section 1. Article 5105 of the Housing Regulations of the District of Columbia is hereby amended by adding the following new section.

"Section 5101. On and after January 1, 1968 the use of any building or other structure or parts thereof as a tenement unit or tenement house is prohibited."

Section 2. Effective Date. This amendment shall become effective twenty days after the date of its passage.





D STREET, S. W.


From 6th Street to 7th Street, on the south side, No Parking at Anytime.



"PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE

From Alabama Avenue to the first alley to the east, on the north side, two hour parking 9:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday."
