

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to appoint Sonia Ramirez to the Occupational Safety and Health Board.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Occupational Safety and Health Board Sonia Ramirez Confirmation Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2014”.

Sec. 2(a) The emergency legislation will appoint Sonia Ramirez as a private sector member of the Occupational Safety and Health Board for a term ending on April 12, 2017.

(b) Sonia Ramirez is the Director of the Government Affairs division of the Building and Construction Trades Department, AFL-CIO. She leads all of the Department’s legislative and political work in infrastructure investment, job creation and labor standards.

(c) Appointments to the Occupational Safety and Health Board require Council approval. With the Council period coming to an end, it is imperative that the appointment of Sonia Ramirez be moved in order to have all seats on the Board occupied so that the members can continue to work towards safer workplaces for District residents.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
