

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, Title 50 of the District of Columbia Official Code to permit former Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2C residents who are now Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E residents to retain use of their Zone 2 residential parking permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E Residential Parking Permit Exception Temporary Amendment Act of 2014”.

Sec. 2. Title 50 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows:

(a) A new Chapter 28 is added to read as follows:

“(a) Former Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2C residents who are now Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E residents shall be permitted to retain use of their Zone 2 residential parking permits.

(b) The boundaries are New Jersey Avenue NW from the 1300 block to Florida Avenue NW and New Jersey Avenue NW, north of New York Avenue NW from the 400 block to the 900 block, east of 9th Street from the 1100 block to P Street NW, P Street NW to P Street West on 11th North on 11th to S Street NW, S Street east to Wiltburger Street .”.

3 statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
4 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

5 Sec. 4. Effective date.

6 (a) This act shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor (or in the event of a veto by
7 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and a 30-day period of Congressional
8 review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
9 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1), and publication in the
10 District of Columbia Register.

11 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.

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
