12 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

15 To authorize, on an emergency basis, the Mayor to establish a time-limited, geographically  
16 defined area surrounding the 2018 Major League Baseball All-Star Game, to establish  
17 temporary prohibitions on vending in the defined area, and to require that a person or  
18 entity vending in the defined area obtain a specific one-event vending site permit.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
21 act may be cited as the “2018 Major League Baseball All-Star Game Stadium Special Events  
22 Zone Emergency Act of 2018”.

23 Sec. 2. Definitions.

24 For the purposes of this act, the term:

25 (1) “MLB All-Star Game” means the 2018 Major League Baseball All-Star Game  
26 to be played on July 17, 2018 at Nationals Park.

27 (2) “Stadium Special Events Permit” means a time-limited vending site permit to  
28 engage in authorized vending activities in the Stadium Special Events Zone.

29 (3) “Stadium Special Events Zone” means the area of land consisting of  
30 approximately 19 acres, bounded by N Street, S.E., Potomac Avenue, S.E., South Capitol Street,  
31 S.E., and First Street, S.E., including the rights-of-way within that area, established pursuant to  
32 section 3(a) of this act.

33 Sec. 3. Stadium Special Events Zone.

34 (a) The Mayor shall establish a Stadium Special Events Zone where, for a period of no  
35 more than 7 days, including the MLB All-Star Game, only a vendor who holds a Stadium Special  
36 Events Permit, valid for the date and time of use, may engage in vending.

37 (b) A vendor who holds a license pursuant to 24 DCMR 503.1 may apply for a Stadium  
38 Special Events Permit.

39 (c) The resale of tickets in public space shall be prohibited in the Stadium Special Events  
40 Zone, pursuant to 24 DCMR 573.8.

41 Sec. 4. Rules

42 The Mayor, pursuant to Title I of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act,  
43 approved October 21, 1968 (82 Stat. 1204; D.C. Official Code § 2-501 *et seq.*), may issue rules  
44 to implement the provisions of this act.

45 Sec. 5. Fiscal impact statement.

46 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
47 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
48 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

49 Sec. 6. Effective date.

50 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
51 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than  
52 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section  
53 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;  
54 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
