A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, Title 17, Chapter 5 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to reauthorize the technology enhancement fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Business License Technology Fee Reauthorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. Section 500.4 of Chapter 5 (Basic Business License Schedule of Fees) of Title 17 (Business, Occupations, and Professions) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations is amended to read as follows:

“500.4 Starting on October 1, 2010, the Director shall charge an additional fee of ten percent (10%) on the total cost of each basic business license to cover the costs of enhanced technological capabilities of the basic business licensing system.”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Office of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Application date.

This act shall apply as of October 1, 2013.

Sec. 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
2 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer
3 than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in
4 Section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87
5 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-204.12(a)).
