A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 15 and 16 and proposed Modification No. 17 to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia to provide occupational and physical therapy services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under option year three of the contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications for Option Year 3 to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 15 and 16 and proposed Modification No. 17 to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia, to provide occupational and physical therapy services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17.

1 (b) By Modification No. 15, dated May 3, 2017, the District of Columbia Public
2 Schools (“DCPS”) increased the estimated amount of option year three from \$2,287,752
3 to \$2,391,543.

4 (c) By Modification No.16, dated June 19, 2017, the DCPS exercised a partial
5 option for option year three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$396,459 for the period from
6 June 20, 2017 through September 30, 2017.

7 (j) By Modification No. 17, DCPS now proposes to exercise the remainder of
8 option year three for the period from October 1, 2017 through June 19, 2018 in the
9 amount of \$1,995,084, making the total estimated amount for option year three
10 \$2,391,543 for the period from June 20, 2017 through June 19, 2018.

11 (k) Council approval is necessary since these modifications increase the contract
12 by more than \$1,000,000 during a 12-month period.

13 (l) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
14 Without this approval, The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the
15 District of Columbia cannot be paid for goods and services provided in excess of
16 \$1,000,000.00 for the contract period June 20, 2017 through June 19, 2018.

17 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
18 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
19 necessary that the Modifications to Option Year 3 of Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D
20 with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia
21 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017 be adopted after a single
22 reading.

23 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
