

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to amend the Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Act of 2016 to extend the Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program through 2018.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Extension Emergency Declaration of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) The Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Act of 2016 established the Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program and authorized the operation of personal delivery devices (PDD) in the Central Business District, pursuant to operational standards to be determined by the District Department of Transportation.

(b) The Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program (“Pilot Program”) is set to expire on December 31, 2017.

(c) The Pilot Program should be extended through 2018, in order to give the District Department of Transportation and personal delivery device operators participating in the Pilot Program the opportunity to collect more data, which can be used to shape permanent legislation.

(d) Permits issued to PDD operators by the District Department of Transportation on or before December 31, 2017, shall remain in effect for a full one year period from the date of

32 issuance, unless otherwise rescinded at the discretion of the Director, in order to allow continued
33 participation in the Pilot Program by current operators.”

34 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
35 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
36 Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Extension Emergency Amendment Act of 2017 be
37 adopted after a single reading.

38 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
