A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. DCRL-2015-R-0100 and proposed Task Order No. T-0001 with Deloitte Consulting LLP for maintenance, operation and enhancements to the Child and Family Services Agency’s web-based Statewide Automated Child Welfare System (SACWIS), known as FACES.NET, and to authorize payment for services received and to be received under the contract and the task order.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DCRL-2015-R-0100 with Deloitte Consulting, LLP. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Contract No. DCRL-2015-R-0100 with Deloitte Consulting LLP and proposed Task Order No. T-0001 to be issued under the contract for maintenance, operation and enhancements to the Child and Family Services Agency’s (“CFSA’s”) web-based Statewide Automated Child Welfare System (SACWIS), known as FACES.NET, and to authorize payment for services received and to be received under this contract and the proposed task order.

1 (b) On August 16, 2016, CFSA awarded Contract No. DCRL-2015-R-
2 0100 to Deloitte Consulting LLP in the amount of \$979,999.92 to provide maintenance
3 and operations services for FACES.NET.

4 (c) The contract included a forward pricing agreement under which
5 CFSA could issue and fund task orders, as needed, to design, develop, and implement
6 enhancements to FACE.NET.

7 (d) CFSA now proposes to issue Task Order No. T-0001 in the amount of
8 \$158,545.00 for enhancements, thereby increasing the base year amount of the contract
9 from \$979,999.92 to \$1,138,544.92.

10 (d) Council approval is necessary because this proposed task order
11 increases the total contract amount to more than \$1,000,000 during a 12-month period.

12 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
13 Without this approval, Deloitte Consulting LLP cannot be paid for services provided in
14 excess of \$1,000,000.00.

15 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
16 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the “Contract No. DCRL-
17 2015-R-0100 with Deloitte Consulting LLP Approval and Payment Authorization
18 Emergency Act of 2017” be adopted after a single reading.

19 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
