

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, the Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Act of 2016 to extend the Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program through 2018.

BE IN ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Extension Emergency Amendment Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. The Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Act of 2016, effective October 8, 2016 (D.C. Law 21-160; D.C. Official Code § 50-1551 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

(a) Section 6193 (D.C. Official Code § 50-1552) is amended by striking the phrase “December 31, 2017” and inserting the phrase “December 31, 2018” in its place.

(b) Section 6195 (D.C. Official Code § 50-1554) is amended by striking the phrase “December 31, 2017, whichever is first.” and inserting the phrase, “December 31, 2018, whichever is first, provided that any registration accepted, and permit issued, by the Director prior to December 31, 2017 shall remain in effect for a full one year period from the date of issuance, unless otherwise rescinded at the discretion of the Director.”

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

30           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
31 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
32 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

33           Sec. 4. Effective date.

34           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
35 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than  
36 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section  
37 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24<sup>th</sup>, 1973 (87 Stat. 788:  
38 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a))
