A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 24, 25, 26, and 27 and proposed Modification No. 28 to Human Care Agreement No. DCRL-2013-H-0039F with Family Matters of Greater Washington to provide case management and traditional and therapeutic family-based foster care services for children and youth during option year three, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under these modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. DCRL-2013-H-0039F with Family Matters of Greater Washington Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 24, 25, 26, and 27 and proposed Modification No. 28 to Human Care Agreement No. DCRL-2013-H-0039F with Family Matters of Greater Washington to provide case management and traditional and therapeutic family-based foster care services for children and youth and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 24, 25, 26, 27 and proposed Modification No. 28.

1 (b) By Modification No. 25, dated December 30, 2016, and Modification No. 24,  
2 dated January 18, 2017, the Child and Family Services Agency (“CFSA”) exercised a  
3 partial option for option year three of Human Care Agreement No. DCRL-2013-H0039F  
4 for the period from January 1, 2017 through January 31, 2017 in the not-to-exceed  
5 amount of \$257,720.76.

6 (c) By Modification No. 26, dated February 1, 2017, CFSA corrected an  
7 administrative error in Modification No. 25 that occurred when the not-to-exceed amount  
8 for the exercise of the first partial option was recorded as \$257,720.76 in Modification  
9 No. 25 when it should have been \$241,332.12.

10 (d) By Modification No. 27, dated February 1, 2017, CFSA exercised a second  
11 partial option in the not-to-exceed amount of \$737,316.06 for the period from February 1,  
12 2017 through April 25, 2017.

13 (e) Modification No. 28 is now necessary to increase the not-to-exceed amount by  
14 \$2,194,393.03, resulting in a total not-to-exceed amount for option year three of  
15 \$3,173,041.21 for the period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

16 (f) Council approval is necessary since these modifications increase the contract  
17 by more than \$1,000,000 during a 12-month period.

18 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
19 Without this approval, Family Matters of Greater Washington cannot be paid for goods  
20 and services provided in excess of \$1,000,000.00 for the contract period from January 1,  
21 2017 through December 31, 2017.

22 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
23 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it

1 necessary that the “Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. DCRL-2013-H-0039F  
2 with Family Matters of Greater Washington Approval and Payment Authorization  
3 Emergency Act of 2017” be adopted after a single reading.

4           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
