A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modifications Nos. 3, 4, 5 and 6 to Contract No. GAGA-2013-C-0029 for option year 2 of corporate purchase buy down account program through the AMEX Corporate Defined Expense Program. The vendor, American Express TRS Company will continue to allow District of Columbia Public Schools to purchase equipment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Contract No. GAGA-2013-C-0029 Modification Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2015”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), Modifications Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. GAGA-2013-C-0029 for option year 2 of the corporate buy down program through the AMEX Corporate Defined Expense Program for the District is approved and payment in the total amount of \$15,000,000.00 for Modifications 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Contract No. GAGA-2013-C-0029 is authorized for services received and to be received under that contract.

1           Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial  
2 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia  
3 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-  
4 206.02(c)(3)).

5           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of  
6 veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no  
7 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in  
8 section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87  
9 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
