**Date:** July 6, 2017

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This memo is to request that the following emergency measures be placed on the agenda for the July 11, 2017, Additional Legislative Meeting:

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0028 with Vision Security Solutions, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017
- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0028 with Vision Security Solutions, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification Nos.1, 2 and 3 and proposed Modification No. 4 to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0028 with Vision Security Solutions, LLC to procure monitoring, maintenance, repair and replacement services for the closed circuit television cameras deployed at District of Columbia Public School sites and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3 and proposed Modification No. 4

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve option year one of Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0028 between DCPS and Vision Security Solution, LLC to procure monitoring, maintenance, repair and replacement services for approximately 6281 closed circuit television cameras deployed at the estimated 119 DCPS sites. The term of the contract is from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, and the estimated contract amount is \$1,244,059.

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification No. 6 and proposed Modification No. 7 to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0036A-2 with DC Central Kitchen to manage the overall food service program to approximately 12 District of Columbia Public Schools and to authorize

payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification No. 6 and proposed Modification No. 7.

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve a contract between District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and DC Central Kitchen for the exercise of option year one, for school year 2017-2018, for Food Services to include preparing, serving, and accounting for meals for approximately 12 assigned DCPS schools classified as cluster 10 (except for Walker-Jones Education Campus in cluster 5 and Woodson High School in cluster 10). School operations are not limited to weekdays and may include evenings and weekends. The services include management of the Schools Breakfast Program, including Breakfast In the Classroom, the National School Lunch Program, the Summer Food Service Program, the After School Supper Program, the After School Snack Program, the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, a la carte meals and items, adult meals, and any other food service programs as required per the contract. The term of the contract is from July 1, 2017 thru June 30, 2018. The estimated contract amount is \$5,620,714.29.

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0036A-1 with SodexoMagic, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification No. 6 and proposed Modification No. 7 to Contract No. GAGA-2016-C-0036A-1 with SodexoMagic, LLC to manage the overall food service program for approximately 101 District of Columbia Public Schools, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification No. 6 and proposed Modification No. 7.

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve a contract between District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and SodexoMagic, LLC for the Food Services program to include preparing, serving and accounting for meals for approximately 101 assigned DCPS schools classified as school clusters 1 to 9 (except for Walker-Jones Education Campus in cluster 5 and Woodson High School in cluster 10). School operations are not limited to weekdays and may include evenings and weekends. The services include management of the Schools Breakfast Program, including Breakfast In the Classroom, the National School Lunch Program, the Summer Food Service Program, the After School Supper Program, the After School Snack Program, the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, a la carte meals and items, adult meals, and any other food service programs as required per the contract. The term of the contract is from July 1, 2017 thru June 30, 2018. The estimated contract amount is \$35,582,105.82

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2015-C-0034 with Tamah, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017
- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2015-C-0034 with Tamah, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification No. 12 and proposed Modification No. 13 to Contract No. GAGA-2015-C-0034 with Tamah, LLC to acquire dedicated aides to provide one-on-one instructional, behavioral, or medical paraprofessional support for students of the District of Columbia Public Schools, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification No. 12 and proposed Modification No. 13.

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve a contract for the exercise of option year two between District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and Tamah, LLC for Dedicated Paraprofessional services such as one-on-one instructional, behavioral, or medical paraprofessional support for students, which are essential for the school year 2017-2018. DCPS has students with disabilities that require services and support of a dedicated one-on-one aide pursuant to their Individualized Education Plan (IEP). In addition, the provisions of the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)* describe school health services as a related service to students with disabilities who would be unable to attend a day of school without supportive health care provided by a qualified school nurse or specifically trained non-medical person who is supervised by a qualified nurse. All contracted medical paraprofessionals must demonstrate credentials commensurate with these provisions of IDEA. The term of the contract is from July 1, 2017 thru June 30, 2018. The estimated contract amount is \$3,474,071.76.

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia to provide occupational and physical therapy services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13.

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve a contract for the exercise of option year two between DCPS and The Futures HealthCore, LLC. Through this contract, the Future HealthCore LLC would continue to provide occupational and physical therapy services to DCPS students with disabilities, in accordance with Individual Education Plans (IEPs), 504 plans, Individual Service Plans (ISPs), and the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)*. The Occupational Therapists (OTs) and Physical Therapists (PTs) provide assessment, consultation and intervention related services in the areas of occupational and physical therapy. The term of the contract was from June 20, 2016 thru June 19, 2017. The estimated contract amount is \$1,787,016.00. *Please place this item on the non-consent agenda.*

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017

- Modifications to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017

There exists an emergency need to approve Modification Nos. 15 and 16 and proposed Modification No. 17 to Contract No. GAGA-2014-C-0026D with The Futures HealthCore, LLC dba Futures Education of the District of Columbia, to provide occupational and physical therapy services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17.

This emergency legislation would retroactively approve a contract for the exercise of option year three between DCPS and The Futures HealthCore, LLC. Through this contract, the Future HealthCore LLC would continue to provide occupational and physical therapy services to DCPS students with disabilities, in accordance with Individual Education Plans (IEPs), 504 plans, Individual Service Plans (ISPs), and the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)*. The Occupational Therapists (OTs) and Physical Therapists (PTs) provide assessment, consultation and intervention related services in the areas of occupational and physical therapy. The term of the contract is from June 20, 2017 thru June 19, 2018. The estimated contract amount is \$2,391,543.00.
