A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 16 and 17 to Contract No. CW29405 with Miriam’s Kitchen to provide permanent supportive housing and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW29405 with Miriam’s Kitchen Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 16 and 17 to Contract No. CW29405 with Miriam’s Kitchen to provide permanent supportive housing and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 16 and 17.

(b) By Modification No.16, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (“OCP”), on behalf of the Department of Human Services, exercised a partial option of option year four from May 23, 2018 through August 22, 2018 in the not-to-exceed amount of \$317,613.

1 (c) Modification No. 17 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option  
2 year four for the amount of \$952,839, to a total not-to-exceed amount of \$1,270,452.

3 (e) Council approval is necessary since these modifications increase the contract  
4 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

5 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
6 Without this approval, Miriam's Kitchen cannot be paid for goods and services provided  
7 in excess of \$1 million for option period four.

8 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
9 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
10 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. CW29405 with Miriam's Kitchen  
11 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2018 be adopted after a single  
12 reading.

13 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
