A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 2, 3, and 4 to Contract No. DCJM-2014-H-0006-10 with RCM of Washington Inc. to provide occupancy-related residential expenses and services to District citizens with intellectual and developmental disabilities and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. DCJM-2014-H-0006-10 with RCM of Washington Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 2, 3, and 4 to Contract No. DCJM-2014-H-0006-10 with RCM of Washington Inc. to provide occupancy-related residential expenses and services to District citizens with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 2, 3, and 4.

(b) By Modification No. 2, dated September 15, 2016, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (“OCP”), on behalf of the Department on Disability Services, exercised a partial option of option year two of Contract No. DCJM-2014-H-0006-10 to provide

1 occupancy-related residential expenses and services to District citizens with intellectual
2 and developmental disabilities for the period from October 1, 2016 to March 30, 2017 in
3 the not-to-exceed amount of \$552,000.00.

4 (c) Modification No. 3, dated December 12, 2016, further modified Contract No.
5 DCJM-2014-H-0006-10.

6 (d) Modification No. 4 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year
7 two and increase the total not-to-exceed amount for the period from October 1, 2016
8 through September 30, 2017 to \$1,103,527.40.

9 (e) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia
10 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-
11 204.51(b)) since these modifications increase the contract to more than \$1,000,000 during
12 a 12-month period.

13 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
14 Without this approval, RCM of Washington Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services
15 provided in excess of \$1,000,000 for the contract period October 1, 2016 through
16 September 30, 2017.

17 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
18 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
19 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. DCJM-2014-H-0006-10 with RCM of
20 Washington Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2017 be
21 adopted after a single reading.

22 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
