A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 020 and 021 to Contract No. DCFA-2015-C-2292-SS/CW37092 with PFC Associates, LLC to provide occupational and ancillary healthcare services at the Police and Fire Clinic, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification to Contract No. DCFA-2015-C-2292SSCW37092/with PFC Associates, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 020 and 021 to Contract No. DCFA-2015-C-2292SS/CW37092 with PFC Associates, LLC to provide occupational and ancillary healthcare services at the Police and Fire Clinic, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. 020, dated April 19, 2018, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Metropolitan Police Department, extended the contract for

1 the period from May 1, 2018, through May 21, 2018, in the total estimated amount of
2 \$941,573.67

3 (c) Modification No. 021 is now necessary to extend the contract from May 1,
4 2018 through July 31, 2018 in the total estimated amount of \$3,113,853.00, thereby
5 increasing the total estimated amount for the period of May 1, 2018 through July 31,
6 2018 to \$4,055,426.67.

7 (d) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia
8 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-
9 204.51(b)) since the unapproved value of the contract is more than \$1,000,000.00 during a
10 12-month period.

11 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
12 Without this approval, PFC Associates, LLC cannot be paid for services provided in
13 excess of \$1,000,000 for the period of May 1, 2018 through July 31, 2018.

14 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
15 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
16 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. DCFA-2015-C-2292SS/CW37092 with
17 PFC Associates, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2018 be
18 adopted after a single reading.

19 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
