A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve multiyear Contract No. DHCF-2017-C-0026 with KPMG LLP to provide services to manage and deliver software enhancements to the District of Columbia Access System (DCAS).

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DHCF-2017-C-0026 Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) The Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Health Care Finance, proposes to enter into a multiyear contract with KPMG LLP to provide services to manage and deliver software enhancements to the District of Columbia Access System (DCAS).

(b) The price under this multiyear contract with KPMG LLP is \$109,900,000.00 for the three-year base period.

(c) Approval is necessary to allow the District to receive the benefit of these vital services in a timely manner from KPMG LLP.

(d) These critical services can only be obtained through an award of the multiyear contract with KPMG LLP.

1 Sec 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
2 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
3 Contract No. DHCF-2017-C-0026 Emergency Approval Resolution of 2018 be adopted
4 after a single reading.

5 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
