19 To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 9 through 11 to Contract No.
20 DCAM-16-NC-0034B with RSC Electric & Mechanical Contractors, Inc., for
21 HVAC technician services for several municipal facilities and District of
22 Columbia Public Schools, and to authorize payment in the aggregate amount of
23 \$1,650,000 for the goods and services received and to be received under the
24 modifications.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

28 That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 9 through 11 to Contract No.
29 DCAM-16-NC-0034B Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2018”.

30 Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
31 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and
32 notwithstanding the requirements of section 202(a) of the Procurement Practices Reform
33 Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-
34 352.02(a)), the Council approves Modification Nos. 9 through 11 to Contract No.
35 DCAM-16-NC-0034B with RSC Electric & Mechanical Contractors, Inc. for on-call
36 heating, air conditioning and ventilation system repairs and upgrades to several municipal

1 facilities and District of Columbia Public Schools and to authorize payment in the
2 aggregate amount of \$1,650,000 for goods and services received and to be received under
3 the modifications.

4 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal statement provided by the Office of the
5 Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4(a) of the
6 General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038;
7 D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47(a)).

8 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
9 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
10 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
11 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
12 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
