A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve PO577679 and Task Order No. 1 under Contract No. CW58099 with Cardinal Health 110, LLC to provide pharmaceutical drugs and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Orders Under Contract No. CW58099 with Cardinal Health 110, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve PO577679 and Task Order No. 1 under Contract No. CW58099 with Cardinal Health 110, LLC to provide pharmaceutical drugs and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under PO577679 and Task Order No. 1.

(b) By PO577679, dated December 29, 2017, the Office of Contracting and Procurement issued an order to Cardinal Health 110, LLC in the amount of \$991,000 to provide pharmaceutical drugs to various District agencies.

1 (c) Task Order No. 1 is now necessary to increase the contract's total not to
2 exceed amount to \$20 million for the period from December 29, 2017 through September
3 30, 2018.

4 (d) Council approval is necessary since these orders cumulatively increase the
5 contract by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

6 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
7 Without this approval, Cardinal Health 110, LLC cannot be paid for goods and services
8 provided in excess of \$1 million for the period from December 29, 2017 through
9 September 30, 2018.

10 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
11 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
12 necessary that the Orders Under Contract No. CW58099 with Cardinal Health 110, LLC
13 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2018 be adopted after a single
14 reading.

15 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
