(c) The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to determine whether income tax secured bonds or notes will be issued to finance or refinance the Projects. If notes are issued to finance the Projects, the Chief Financial Officer shall determine when and whether New Communities Initiative income tax secured bonds or notes will be issued to refund or refinance the outstanding notes.

## Sec. 5. Allocation of funds.

If the funds allocated to any agency pursuant to this resolution exceed the amount required by that agency to complete the Projects, the excess funds shall be made available to finance other New Communities Initiative projects approved by a subsequent New Communities Initiative project bond issuance resolution.

## Sec. 6. Authorization of action.

The Council approves the execution and delivery by the Mayor, Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, or the Chief Financial Officer, on behalf of the District, of any agreement, document, contract, and instrument (including any amendment or supplement to any such agreement, document, contract, or instrument) in connection with the issuance, sale, and delivery of District of Columbia income tax secured bonds or notes pursuant to this resolution.
