A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. NFPHC-2018-435-A Modification 2 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates, Inc., (“GW MFA”) to provide emergency department services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. NFPHC-2018 - 435-A Modification 2 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and GW Medical Faculty Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2019”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Contract No. NFPHC-2018-435A Modification 2 (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and GW MFA, to provide emergency department services to the Hospital and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

(b) The original base year of the Contract, approved by Council in March 2018 (CA22-408), was terminated after the Parties discovered an error in the pricing.

37 (c) A corrected six (6) month FY 18 portion of base period was funded for
38 \$4,407,762.00 and approved by Council in July 2018.

39 (d) Modification 1 was the FY 19 portion of the base period (October 1, 2018 –
40 March 22, 2019, 6 months) in the amount of \$4,407,762.00, for a corrected total 12-
41 month value of \$8,815,524.00 and was approved by the Council in December 2018.

42 (e) Proposed Modification 2 seeks to address the FY 19 portion of option year 1
43 (March 23, 2019 – September 30, 2019, 6 months) in the amount of \$4,407,762.00.

44 (f) This Contract has an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month
45 period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.

46 (g) Emergency approval of this Contract for \$4,407,762.00 is necessary to
47 prevent any impact to the hospital's provision of emergency department services.

48 (h) Without this approval, GW MFA cannot be paid for these critical services
49 provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

50 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
51 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Contract No. NFPHC-2018-
52 435-A Modification 2 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and GW Medical
53 Faculty Associates, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment
54 Act of 2019, be adopted after a single reading.

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
