

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To symbolically designate, on a temporary basis, the alley located in Square 965 located between 10th Street N.E. and 11th Street, N.E., and Constitution Avenue, N.E., in Ward 6, as Al and Mary Arrighi Way.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Al and Mary Arrighi Way Designation Temporary Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Designation.

Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the alley located in Square 965, between 10th Street, N.E., and 11th Street, N.E., and Constitution Avenue, N.E., in Ward 6, as “Al and Mary Arrighi Way”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

35 Sec. 5. Effective date.

36 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
37 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
38 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,
39 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
40 Columbia Register.

41 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
