A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 3 and 4 to Human Care Agreement No. CW68847 with Constituent Services Worldwide Public Benefit Corporation to provide the Education and Occupational Training services to adult Temporary Assistance for Needy Families customers and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that human care agreement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. CW68847 with Constituent Services Worldwide Public Benefit Corporation Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 3 and 4 to Human Care Agreement No. CW68847 with Constituent Services Worldwide Public Benefit Corporation to provide Education and Occupational Training services to adult Temporary Assistance for Needy

1 Families customers, and authorizes payment in the total not-to-exceed amount of
2 \$2,466,013 for the goods and services received and to be received under the human care
3 agreement for the period from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.

4 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief
5 Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General
6 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C.
7 Official Code § 1-301.47a).

8 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
9 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
10 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
11 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
12 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
