A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C-1 Modifications between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. to provide Food and Nutrition services to the Hospital, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C-1 Modifications between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C-1 (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc, to provide Food and Nutrition services to the Hospital and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

36 (b) Due to several factors, including leadership changes, the Hospital was unable
37 to effectuate its planned competitive procurement for food and nutrition services prior to
38 the expiration of option year four (4) of the last Council approved contract with Morrison
39 (A22-557).

40 (c) To avoid a gap in these critical services, the Parties entered into a 120-day
41 sole source letter contract in August 2019 in amount of \$739,391.33.

42 (d) Under new executive leadership, all procurements are being reviewed, so
43 prior to the expiration of the letter contract and pursuant to its terms, the Parties agreed to
44 definitize the contract with an eight (8) month extension for \$1,478,782.81.

45 (e) The new definitized contract consisting of the letter contract and the eight (8)
46 month extension has a total period of August 1, 2019 to July 31, 2020, and a total value
47 of \$2,218,174.14.

48 (f) This Contract has an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month
49 period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.

50 (h) Emergency approval of this Contract for \$2,218,174.14 is necessary to
51 prevent any impact to the hospital's provision of Food and Nutrition services.

52 (i) Without this approval, Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. cannot be paid
53 for these critical services provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

54 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
55 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-
56 20-C-1 Modifications between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Morrison

57 Management Specialist, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency

58 Amendment Act of 2020, be adopted after a single reading.

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
