SUBJECT: Requests for the October 20, 2020 Additional Legislative Meeting

I request that the following emergency measures be agendized for the October 20th Additional Legislative Meeting:

- CleanEnergy DC Omnibus Technical Amendment Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020
- CleanEnergy DC Omnibus Technical Amendment Emergency Amendment Act of 2020
- CleanEnergy DC Omnibus Technical Amendment Temporary Amendment Act of 2020

On October February 4, 2020, the Council passed the CleanEnergy DC Omnibus Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, which expired on May 27, 2020. On March 3, 2020, the Council passed the CleanEnergy DC Omnibus Temporary Amendment Act of 2020, which will expire on December 17, 2020. Immediate legislative action is necessary to prevent a gap in the law following the expiration of the temporary act, and to make additional, minor amendments to clarify how DOEE may publish certain standards under the Building Energy Performance Standards Program, and to allow additional time for DGS to develop a strategic energy management plan.
