A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve on an emergency basis, a multi-year Dedicated Funding Grant Agreement with the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) to provide capital funding for state-of-good-repair capital needs for fiscal years 2021 through 2026.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Fiscal Year 2021 to 2026 Dedicated Funding Grant Agreement Emergency Approval Resolution of 2020”.

Sec. 2. (a) The District Department of Transportation, on behalf of the Mayor, proposes to enter into a multiyear Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Fiscal Year 2021 to 2026 Dedicated Funding Grant Agreement with the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) to provide capital funding for the state-of-good-repairs capital needs for the Washington Metro System from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2026.

(b) The price under this Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Fiscal Year 2021 to 2026 Dedicated Funding Grant Agreement with WMATA is in the amount not to exceed \$1,154,611,166.

1 (c) Approval is necessary in order for the District to ensure that its residents and
2 visitors have a transit system that is in a state of good repair.

3 Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 451(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
4 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; DC Official Code § 1-204.51(c)(3)), the
5 Council approves the multiyear Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Fiscal
6 Year 2021 to 2026 Dedicated Funding Grant Agreement.
