28 “(a-1)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or order to the contrary, the initial
29 term of the Adams Morgan BID began, pursuant to Mayor’s Order 2005-121 dated August 22,
30 2005, on June 30, 2005, and expired on September 30, 2011.

31 “(2) This subsection shall apply as of January 1, 2010.”.

40 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
41 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).

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
