22 To approve, on an emergency basis, multiyear Contract No. DCCB-2021-F-0008 with Motley  
23 Rice, LLC, to provide legal services to the Office of the Attorney General, and to  
24 authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the  
25 modifications.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
28 act may be cited as the “Contract No. DCCB-2021-F-0008 with Motley Rice, LLC Approval and  
29 Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021”.

30 Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
31 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and section 202 of the  
32 Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C.  
33 Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves multiyear Contract No. DCCB-2020-F-0008  
with Motley Rice, LLC, to provide legal services to the Office of the Attorney General for a  
consumer protection and false-claims matter, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed  
amount of \$55 million for goods and services received and to be received under Contract No.  
DCCB-2021-F-0008.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial  
Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative

34 Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-  
35 301.47a).

36           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of  
37 veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no  
38 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in  
39 Section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87  
40 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
