7 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

9 To amend, on an emergency basis, Section 29-102.12, to have no late fee for delivering biennial
10 report for 2021 if the biennial report for 2021 is delivered to the Mayor for filing by June
11 30, 2021.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
14 act may be cited as the “Corporate Filing Extension Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of
15 2021”.

16 Sec. 2. Corporate filing extension clarification.

17 The amendatory section 29-102.12 of the District of Columbia Official Code in section
18 (July 2, 2011, D.C. Law 18-378, § 2, 58 DCR 1720; effective March 17, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-247;
19 is amended to read as follows:

20 “(e) There shall be no late fee for delivering the biennial report for 2021 required by §
21 29-102.11(c); provided, that the biennial report for 2021 be delivered to the Mayor for filing by
22 June 30, 2021.”.

23 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

24 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
25 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
26 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code §1-301.47a).

27 Sec. 4. Effective date.

28 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
29 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
30 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
31 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
32 Columbia Register.
