A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. to provide Level III substance abuse treatment services to the District and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. to provide Level III substance abuse treatment services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. 8, dated July 20, 2020, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health, executed a partial Option Year 3 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS

1 with RAP, Inc., for the period from July 21, 2020 through September 30, 2020, in the
2 not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000.

3 (c) By Modification No. 9, dated August 28, 2020, the Office of Contracting
4 and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health, extended partial
5 Option Year 3 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS
6 with RAP, Inc., for the period from September 30, 2020 through December 31, 2020, but
7 added no money to the contract.

8 (d) By Modification No. 10, dated October 27, 2020, the Office of Contracting
9 and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health, executed an
10 additional partial Option Year 3 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-
11 011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc., for the period from December 31, 2020 through
12 January 31, 2021, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$790,000, increasing the total not-to-
13 exceed amount to \$990,000.

14 (e) By Modification No. 11, dated December 22, 2020, the Office of
15 Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health,
16 extended partial Option Year 3 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-
17 011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc., for the period from January 31, 2021 through
18 February 28, 2021, but added no money to the contract.

19 (f) By Modification No. 12 dated February 3, 2021, the Office of Contracting
20 and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health, extended partial
21 Option Year 3 to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS
22 with RAP, Inc., for the period from February 28, 2021 through March 31, 2021, but
23 added no money to the contract.

1 (g) Modification No. 13 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of Option
2 Year 3 for the period from April 1, 2021 through July 20, 2021 in the not-to-exceed
3 amount of \$1,210,000, which will increase the total not-to-exceed amount for Option
4 Year 3 to \$2,200,000.

5 (h) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia
6 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1–
7 204.51(b)), since these modifications increase the contract to more than \$1,000,000
8 during a 12-month period.

9 (i) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
10 Without this approval, RAP, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services provided in
11 excess of \$1,000,000 for the contract period beginning July 21, 2020 through July 20,
12 2021.

13 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
14 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
15 necessary that the Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-
16 011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency
17 Act of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.

18 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
