Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable before the Committee of the Whole on vacant and blighted properties in the District of Columbia. The roundtable will be held on **Tuesday, May 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast**. The original roundtable notice erroneously stated that the date as Monday, May 25, 2021. This notice has been revised to reflect the fact that the correct date is Tuesday, May 25, 2021.

Research consistently shows that vacant and blighted properties have myriad negative effects on the surrounding area, including reductions in the value of nearby homes and increases in crime. The purpose of this roundtable is to hear from Advisory Neighborhood Commissioners about vacant and blighted properties in their districts that have been particularly problematic, including what—if any—action the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs has taken to address issues raised by ANC Commissioners and residents about the properties. **The hearing is limited to invited witnesses only.**

Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency declaration, the roundtable will be conducted virtually on the Internet utilizing Zoom video conference technology. Although the witness list for this roundtable is limited, written or transcribed statements from the public are welcome and will be taken by email or voicemail.
