A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, the negotiated compensation agreement for special police and security officers employed by the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and who are represented by the United Federation of Special Police and Security Officers, Inc.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and the United Federation of Special Police and Security Officers, Inc. Emergency Approval Resolution of 2021”.

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to Section 1717(j) of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-617.17(j)), the Council of the District of Columbia approves the collective bargaining agreement and attached related pay schedules, negotiated through collective bargaining between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and the United Federation of Special Police and Security Officers, Inc. (“UFSPO”), which was transmitted to the Council by the Hospital on June 23, 2021.
