A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To recognize and honor Kristy Greenwalt for her exceptional service as the Executive Director of the District of Columbia Interagency Council on Homelessness, upon the occasion of her stepping down as the Director of the agency.

WHEREAS, Kristy Greenwalt has served as the Executive Director of the District of Columbia Interagency Council on Homelessness since 2014;

WHEREAS, Ms. Greenwalt served as the first ever Executive Director of the District of Columbia Interagency Council on Homelessness, setting the stage for excellence in this position and creating a strategy and vision to end homelessness in the District;

WHEREAS, during her tenure, Ms. Greenwalt led a group of stakeholders in the development of Homeward DC, a bold vision to work with local partners and end chronic homelessness in the District;

WHEREAS, under her leadership Ms. Greenwalt oversaw the first ever strategic plan to end youth homelessness in the District, Solid Foundations, based on a DC Youth Count implemented under Ms. Greenwalt's leadership;

1 WHEREAS, Ms. Greenwalt has served as the Co-Chair of the Metropolitan
2 Washington Council of Government’s Homeless Services Committee, coordinating the
3 region around successful strategies to end homelessness;

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Greenwalt brought years of expertise around ending
5 homelessness in the District from her time as Director of Housing Policy for the United
6 States Interagency Council on Homelessness;

7 WHEREAS, Ms. Greenwalt exemplifies public service and excellence;

8 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
9 this resolution may be cited as the “Kristy Greenwalt Recognition Resolution of 2021.”
