22	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
23	this resolution may be cited as the "Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority
24	Fiscal Years 2022 to 2027 Capital Funding Agreement Emergency Declaration
25	Resolution of 2021".
26	Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve the Capital Funding Agreement with the
27	Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) and the contributing
28	jurisdictions consisting of the District; the State of Maryland; Arlington County, Virginia
29	Fairfax County, Virginia; County of Loudoun, Virginia; the City of Alexandria, Virginia;
30	the City of Fairfax, Virginia; and the City of Falls Church, Virginia; to provide new
31	capital funding for the capital improvement program for the Washington metro system from
32	July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2027.
33	(b) On July 1, 2010, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP), on behalf
34	of the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), executed a multiyear Capital

- 1 Funding Agreement with WMATA to provide capital funding for a capital improvement
- 2 program from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2016 in the ceiling amount of \$397,314,000.
- 3 (c) On July 1, 2016, OCP, on behalf of DDOT, executed a modification to the
- 4 multiyear Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to increase the amount for fiscal
- 5 year 2016 by \$92,100,000 for a total ceiling amount of \$489,414,000.
- 6 (d) On July 1, 2017, the OCP, on behalf of DDOT, executed a second
- 7 modification to the multiyear Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to increase the
- 8 amount for fiscal year 2018 by \$76,100,000 for a total ceiling amount of \$565,514,000
- 9 (e) On July 1, 2018, OCP, on behalf of DDOT, executed a third modification to
- the multiyear Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to increase the amount for fiscal
- 11 year 2020 by \$75,235,000 for a total ceiling amount of \$640,749,000.
- 12 (f) A one-year Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to provide
- \$92,700,000 in capital funding for a capital improvement program from July 1, 2019 to
- 14 June 30, 2020 was executed.
- 15 (g) A one-year Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to provide
- \$95,116,884 in capital funding for a capital improvement program from July 1, 2020 to
- 17 June 30, 2021 was executed.
- 18 (h) A new six-year Capital Funding Agreement with WMATA to provide
- 19 \$631,346,120 in capital funding for a capital improvement program from July 1, 2021 to
- June 30, 2027 is now necessary. This capital funding excludes Passenger Rail
- 21 Investment and Improvement Act funding.
- 22 (i) Council approval is necessary since this is a multiyear agreement for more
- 23 than \$1,000,000.

1 (j) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. 2 Without this approval, WMATA cannot be paid for services provided in excess of \$1,000,000.00 for the contract period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2027. 3 4 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the 5 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it 6 necessary that the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Fiscal Years 2022 to 7 2027 Capital Funding Agreement Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single 8 reading. 9 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
