A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Andre Lee worked at the Department of Public Works for over 20 years;

WHEREAS, Andre Lee joined the District of Columbia Office of Cable Television, Film, Music, and Entertainment in 2017. In his role as a Program Support and Community Outreach Specialist, he worked with community groups and leaders to support local initiatives and events;

41 WHEREAS, Andre Lee runs the Senators Satchel Paige Little League where he provides
42 youth in Wards 4 and 5 the opportunity to develop skills, leadership, teamwork, and mentoring
43 relationships;

44 WHEREAS, Andre Lee regularly serves his community through his food ministry in
45 partnership with MidCity. Through this effort, Mr. Lee provides groceries to over 300 families in
46 Ward 5 every week;

48 WHEREAS, Andre Lee has cultivated a reputation as a respected community leader and

51 WHEREAS, a party will be held for Andre Lee at the Ivy City Smokehouse in Ward 5 to
52 celebrate the occasion of his retirement.
