19 To require, on an emergency basis, the Metropolitan Police Department to provide a written  
20 report every 2 pay periods on its overtime pay spending to the Council, and to require  
21 those reports to include the amount spent year-to-date on overtime pay and describe the  
22 staffing plan and conditions justifying the overtime pay.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
25 act may be cited as the “Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability  
26 Temporary Act of 2021”.

27 Sec. 2. Metropolitan Police Department overtime pay reporting.

28 (a) The Metropolitan Police Department (“MPD”) shall provide a written report every 2  
29 pay periods on MPD’s overtime pay spending to the Council.

30 (b) The reports required by subsection (a) of this section shall include the amount spent  
31 year-to-date on overtime pay, and a description of the staffing plan and conditions justifying the  
32 overtime pay.

33 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

34 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
35 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
36 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

37 Sec. 4. Effective date.

38 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by  
39 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review  
40 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
41 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
42 Columbia Register.

43 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
