A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales to provide Horton Ambulances to the District of Columbia Fire Emergency and Medical Services, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales to provide Horton Ambulances to the District of Columbia Fire Emergency and Medical Services, and authorizes payment in

34 the amount not-to-exceed \$7,430,976.00 for the goods and services received and to be  
35 received under the modifications.

36           Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief  
37 Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General  
38 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C.  
39 Official Code § 1-301.47a).

40           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the  
41 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain  
42 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the  
43 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,  
44 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
