A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to require the Metropolitan Police Department to timely report overspending in overtime pay to the Council.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) Mostly recently, on October 5, 2021, the Council passed the Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Emergency Act of 2021, effective October 26, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-187; 68 DCR 11339) (“emergency act”), which will expire on January 24, 2022.

(b) On November 2, 2021, the Council passed the Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Temporary Act of 2021, enacted on November 23, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-219; 68 DCR 12382) (“temporary act”), which is awaiting transmittal for congressional review.

33 (c) This congressional review emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the  
34 law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

35 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
36 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the  
37 Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Congressional Review  
38 Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

39 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
