

SUBJECT: Request to Place Emergency Measures on the Agenda for May 3, 2022
Legislative Meeting

This memo is to request that the following measures be placed on the agenda for the May 3, 2022 Legislative Meeting:

- **Contract No. NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 Modifications between Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2022**
- **Contract No. NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 Modifications between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022**

This emergency legislation and declaration resolution would provide retroactive approval for Contract No. NFPHC-NSD-21-C-00027 Modifications between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. for the provision of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

To maintain these vital services, the Hospital entered into Modification #5 of the Contract for \$143,835.62 for the period of December 9, 2021 to December 24, 2021. Proposed Modification #6 would extend the term to June 22, 2022, with a value of \$1,726,027.40. Council action is necessary to approve the proposed Modification #6 because if approved, the partial Option Year 1 value would be \$1,869,863.02 for period of December 9, 2021 to June 22, 2022.

Emergency approval of this legislation and declaration resolution would approve Modification #5 and Proposed Modification #6 and would enable Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. to receive payment for the provision of these critical nurse staffing services at UMC.
