

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, the D.C. Official Code to allow cooperatives to conduct remote meetings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Coronavirus Support Remote Cooperative Association Meetings Emergency Amendment Act of 2022”.

Sec. 2. Section 29-910 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by striking the phrase “If authorized by the articles or bylaws” and inserting the phrase “Regardless of whether remote regular and special meetings of members are authorized by the articles or bylaws” in its place.

Sec. 3. Sunset.

This act shall expire on October 13, 2022.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by

27 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer
28 than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in
29 section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87
30 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
