17 To recognize and honor the 50-year career of Garlinda Bryant-Rollins, District of
18 Columbia employee, on the occasion of her retirement.

19 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins was born Garlinda Bryant in North Carolina to
20 parents Clinton and Helen Bryant;

21 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins migrated to Washington, D.C. in 1971, with the
22 intention of returning to North Carolina to attend Fayetteville State University. However, after her
23 father became ill, Garlinda began working for the District to help financially support her family;

24 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins has spent her career in the Department of Human
25 Services, working to provide economic stability and security for District residents;

26 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins served in a number of positions in the District
27 government, including personnel clerk, secretary, program manager, supervisory IT specialist, and
28 assistant deputy administrator;

29 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins' last position in the District government is as the
30 Deputy Administrator for the Division of Program Operations in the Economic Security
31 Administration;

32 WHEREAS, after dedicating her professional life to the District of Columbia, Garlinda
33 Bryant-Rollins will be missed by her colleagues, but looks forward to beginning a new phase of
34 her life;

35 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins is married to Wayne E. Rollins and has six children;

37 WHEREAS, Garlinda Bryant-Rollins will retire on April 30, 2022, after more than 50 years
38 of service for the District of Columbia.

40 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this
41 resolution may be cited as the “Garlinda Bryant-Rollins Retirement Recognition Resolution of
42 2022”.
