

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to establish the Career Mobility Action Plan pilot program to combat the negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic by assisting households through the removal of financial disincentives to pursuing higher earnings through employment from loss of eligibility for various public assistance programs.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) On May 3, 2022, the Council passed the Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Emergency Act of 2022, effective May 23, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-433; 69 DCR 6253) (“emergency act”), which will expire on August 21, 2022.

(b) On June 7, 2022, the Council passed on second reading the Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Temporary Act of 2022, enacted on July 6, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-465) (“temporary act”), which is awaiting transmittal for congressional review.

(c) Congressional review emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Career
