

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to  
2 amend section 29-910 of the District of Columbia Official Code to allow all cooperatives to  
3 conduct remote meetings

5 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
6 resolution may be cited as the “Coronavirus Support Remote Cooperative Association Meetings  
7 Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

8 Sec. 2. (a) On May 3, 2022, the Council passed the Coronavirus Support Remote  
9 Cooperative Association Meetings Emergency Amendment Act of 2022, effective May 23, 2022  
10 (D.C. Act 24-422; 69 DCR 6231) (“emergency legislation”), amending, on an emergency basis,  
11 section 29-910 of the District of Columbia Official Code to allow all cooperatives to conduct  
12 remote meetings.

13 (b) On June 7, 2022, the Council passed on second reading the Coronavirus Support  
14 Remote Cooperative Association Meetings Temporary Amendment Act of 2022, passed on 2nd  
15 reading on June 7, 2022 (Enrolled version of Bill 24-782) (“temporary legislation”). The

16 temporary legislation has a sunset date of October 13, 2022. The temporary legislation, which  
17 was transmitted to the Mayor on June 22, 2022, does not yet have a projected law date.

18 (c) The emergency legislation will expire on August 21, 2022, before the temporary  
19 legislation will become law.

20 (d) It is important that the provisions of the emergency legislation continue in effect,  
21 without interruption, until the temporary legislation is in effect.

22 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
23 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the  
24 Coronavirus Support Remote Cooperative Association Meetings Congressional Review  
25 Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

26 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
