

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to adjust certain allocations in the Fiscal Year 2022 Local Budget Act of 2021 to maintain a balanced budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Fiscal Year 2022 Revised Local Budget Adjustment Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) On April 19, 2022, the Council passed the Fiscal Year 2022 Revised Local Budget Adjustment Emergency Act of 2022, enacted April 25, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-388; 69 DCR 4049) (“Emergency Act”), which adjusted certain allocations in the Fiscal Year 2022 Local Budget Act of 2021 and will expire on July 24, 2022.

(b) On May 3, 2022, the Council passed the Fiscal Year 2022 Revised Local Budget Adjustment Temporary Act of 2022, enacted June 3, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-434; 69 DCR 6258) (“Temporary Act”), which is substantially similar to the Emergency Act. The projected law date of the Temporary Act is August 2, 2022.

(c) The congressional review period for the Temporary Act will create a gap in authority between expiration of the Emergency Act and the effective date of the Temporary Act. A congressional review emergency act is necessary to avoid that gap in the authority for the

36 adjustments to the Fiscal Year 2022 budget.

37 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
38 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Fiscal
39 Year 2022 Revised Local Budget Adjustment Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2022 be
40 adopted after a single reading.

41 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
