A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 14 and 15 to Contract No. CW68868 with Unity Health Care, Inc. to provide comprehensive health care services to the residents of the Central Detention Facility, the Correctional Treatment Facility, and the Central Cell Block and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 14 and 15 to Contract No. CW68868 with Unity Health Care, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 14 and 15 to Contract No. CW68868 with Unity Health Care, Inc., to provide comprehensive health care services to the residents of the Central Detention Facility, the Correctional Treatment Facility, and the Central Cell Block, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 14, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Corrections, exercised a partial option of option year three of

35 Contract No. CW68868 for \$10,573,609 for the period April 15, 2022 through July 31,  
36 2022.

37 (c) Modification No. 15 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year  
38 three through April 14, 2023 and increase the total not-to-exceed amount to \$36,271,403  
39 for option year three.

40 (d) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract  
41 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

42 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
43 Without this approval, Unity Health Care, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services  
44 provided in excess of \$1 million for the period April 15, 2022 through April 14, 2023.

45 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
46 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
47 necessary that the Modification Nos. 14 and 15 to Contract No. CW68868 with Unity  
48 Health Care, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2022 be  
49 adopted after a single reading.

50 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
