A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative, to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 6, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Child and Family Services Agency, exercised a partial option of option year one of

34 Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 for \$999,211.50 for the period October 1, 2021  
35 through May 13, 2022.

36 (c) Modification No. 6a modified the contract terms for no additional cost.

37 (d) Modification No. 6b is an administrative modification.

38 (e) There is no Modification No. 7.

39 (f) Modification No. 8 modified the consumer price index cap.

40 (g) Modification No. 9 is an administrative modification.

41 (h) Modification No. 10 exercised another partial option of option year one for  
42 \$350,835.05 for the period May 14, 2022 through July 31, 2022.

43 (i) Modification No 11 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year  
44 one from August 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022 for a total not-to-exceed amount of  
45 \$1,620,943.71 for option year one.

46 (j) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract  
47 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

48 (k) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.

49 Without this approval, Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative cannot be paid for  
50 goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period October 1, 2021  
51 through September 30, 2022.

52 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
53 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
54 necessary that the Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-  
55 2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment  
56 Authorization Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
