RE: Request to Agendize Measures for the July 12, 2022 Additional Legislative Meeting
DATE: July 7, 2022

I am requesting that the following measures be agendized for the July 12, 2022, Additional Legislative Meeting:

Ceremonial Resolution:

- **“Alice Horton Ceremonial Resolution of 2022”**

This ceremonial resolution recognizes, honors, and celebrates Alicia Horton’s leadership and guidance as the Executive Director of Thrive DC and exemplary service and contribution to the District of Columbia

Congressional Review Emergency Legislation:

- **“Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution 2022”**
- **“Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2022”**

On May 3, 2022, the Council passed the Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Emergency Act of 2022, effective May 23, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-433; 69 DCR 6253) (“emergency act”), which will expire on August 21, 2022. On June 7, 2022, the Council passed on second reading the Career Mobility Action Plan Program Establishment Temporary Act of 2022, enacted on July 6, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-465) (“temporary act”), which is awaiting transmittal for congressional review. Congressional review emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

Emergency Contract Legislation at the Request of the Mayor:

- **“Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”**
- **“Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2022”**

This emergency contract legislation would approve Modification Nos. 6, 6a, 6b, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with the Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract. Modification No. 6 allows the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Child and Family Services Agency, to exercise a partial option of option year one of Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 for \$999,211.50 for the period October 1, 2021 through May 13, 2022. Modification No. 6a modifies the contract terms for no additional cost. Modification No. 6b is an administrative modification. Modification No. 8 modifies the consumer price index cap. Modification No. 9 is an administrative modification. Modification No. 10 exercises another partial option of option year one for \$350,835.05 for the period May 14, 2022 through July 31, 2022. Modification No 11 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year one from August 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$1,620,943.71 for option year one. Accordingly, Council approval is required.
